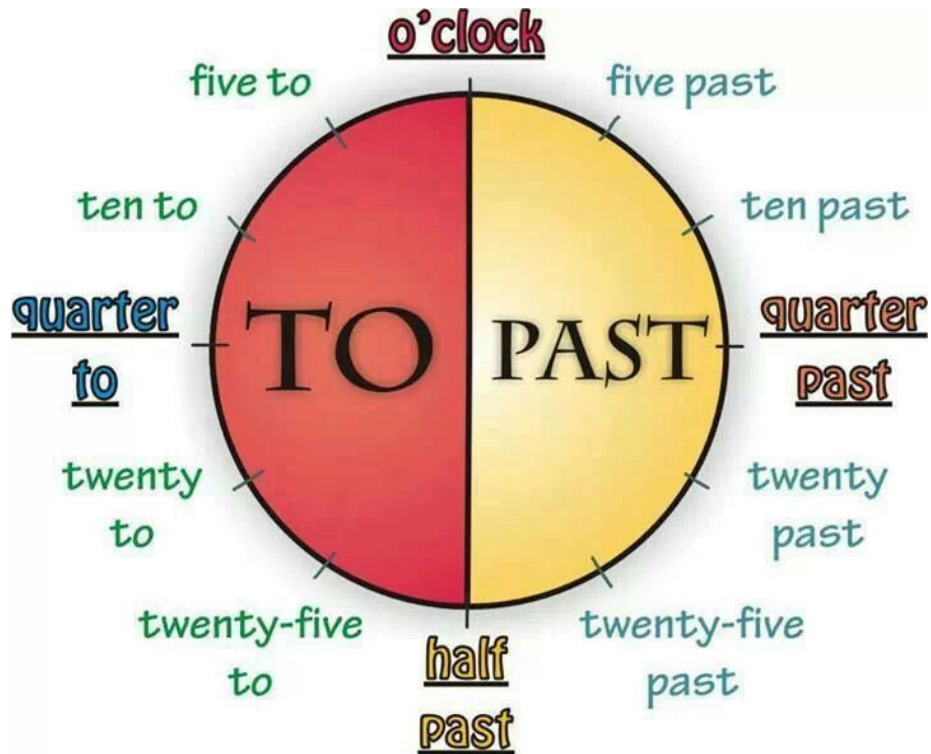

It's two **o'clock**.



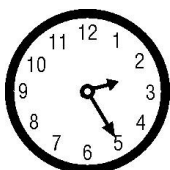
It's **half past** eight.



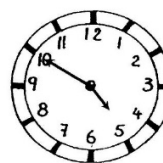
It's **quarter past** seven.

EXPRESSING FREQUENCY

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

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WORD ORDER

POSITIVE	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	VERB	He often cooks pasta.
	SUBJECT	BE	FREQUENCY ADVERB	You are always late.
QUESTION	AUXILIARY	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	Are you always late? Does he often cook?



Use NEVER and HARDLY EVER with positive verbs

✗ He isn't never late.

✓ He is never late.

✗ They don't hardly ever go to the library.

✓ They hardly ever go to the library.
